STATEMENT OF COUNCIL'S JUSTIFICATION TM2/22/523 — ELMS STREET, WHITEFIELD

A request had been received in 2018 from the Whitefield Conservative Club located on Elms Street to remove a section of 'double yellow lines' which were currently in place on both sides of Elms Street, to accommodate limited waiting for visitors of the club.

Due to the lack of parking spaces within the Club's boundaries, the Club's representative has requested that a short stay parking facility be considered on Elms Street in the vicinity of the Conservative Club. There is limited parking within the constraints of the club's boundary (approximately 1 vehicle space). The Conservative Club is situated opposite Morrison's Service yard and next to Whitefield Methodist Church. Consequently, a Mon-Sat, 2 hour/no return within 2 hours, 2 space limited waiting bay was introduced along the northerly side of Elms Street just after the entrance to Morrisons service yard.

However, there are concerns that the limited waiting bay is too close to the nearby Synagogue and its car park entrance.

In view of the above, there is a viable option to relocate the limited waiting bay to the southerly side of Elms Street just after the entrance to the supermarket service yard to maintain the on-street parking facility and alleviate Synagogue concerns.

Morrisons service yard has a turning circle diameter of 26 metres hence delivery vehicles can turn of Elms Street directly into it and then reverse from here into a covered unloading area and as such any parking east of this entrance will not impede delivery vehicles.

Relocating limited parking onto the southerly side, rather than the northerly side, will also ease access into Morrisons Elm Street customer car park entrance.

This report was circulated to the Traffic Management Unit members for comments on Tuesday 31 May 2022, the decision being to recommend the relocation of limited waiting & reinstatement of no waiting at any time restrictions to alleviate these issues.

The extent of the proposed restrictions are described in the accompanying schedule.




