To establish the post of SEND Communications and Engagement Officer (grade 8) as a permanent post on the staffing structure. The key responsibilities are in the area/s for: engagement with parents/carers of children and young people with SEND; signposting parents/carers to SEND services; promoting and supporting positive communication about SEND to parents, stakeholders, staff etc. This is a requirement in the SEND Code of Practice 2014.  This was initially a temporary post in order to evaluate the impact. The current postholder has had since their appointment a tangible impact on parental engagement in the borough over the last 6 months and has built up confidence in relationships between parents, the Council and CCG and is actively promoting the Bury local offer.				
The post sits within the children's commissioning team within the health and social care directorate. This ensures that parental engagement is system wide and that there are strengthened communication mechanisms across CCG and Council education, social care and health services, and that parents are strategically involved by commissioners/service managers in the coproduction of services for SEND.
