Summary:

Following review of operational arrangements, it has been determined that the work of the Children's Rights Team (Comprising 1 x Team Manager and 2 x Children's Rights Workers) would be more effectively aligned to the CASS and Through Care Management Structure.

The work of the team, advocating for children and young people in care and promoting their voice and rights, is complementary to the work of the CASS & Through Care Service, and will ensure more effective joint working and collaboration.

The only operational implication of the transfer is that the Children's Rights Team manager will be operationally managed by the Head of Service (CASS & leaving Care), rather than the Service manager (Quality & Assurance).

Managers and employees impacted by the proposal are supportive of the transfer.
