STATEMENT OF COUNCIL'S JUSTIFICATION

TM2/23/540 — RINGLEY RD/OLD HALL LANE & RINGLEY RD/OLD HALL RD, WHITEFIELD

Concern has been expressed via Casework (from Ward Councillors) regarding parked vehicles causing visibility, access and obstruction problems for vehicular traffic on Ringley Rd (A667, classified Road) and Old Hall Rd and there has been one slight injury accident recorded on the collision database at this location.

On-street parking on Ringley Rd both sides of this junction have been restricting visibility.

In addition, observations have also indicated mainly evenings and weekends double parking on Old Hall Rd near to its junction with Ringley Rd which can cause access difficulties and potential problems for vehicles turning into Old Hall Lane from the busy main road (Ringley Rd) particularly if more than one vehicle makes the turning at any one time.

The Forestry Commission have grounds nearby and this area is popular with many visitors/dog walkers etc coming by car and large vans to the local area.

It is worth noting that there have been previous concerns regarding both these issues.

Both this location would therefore benefit from parking restrictions in order to facilitate vehicle turning movements at these junctions and alleviate visibility, access and obstruction problems. It is anticipated that residents will not have any issues if they maximize their off-street parking and/or displace to a safer locations nearby.

To alleviate the problem it is proposed to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions as indicated on the attached plans.

This report was circulated to the Traffic Management Unit members for comments on Tuesday 30 May 2023, the decision being to recommend the introduction of no waiting at any time restrictions to visibility, alleviate access and obstruction problems.

The extent of the proposed restrictions are described in the accompanying schedule.



Old Hall Lane, Whitefield – Both sides from the southerly kerblines of Ringley Rd for a distance of 15 m in a southerly direction

Ringley Rd, Whitefield – South-easterly side, from a point 15 m west of the westerly kerblines of Old Hall Road to a point 19 m east of the easterly kerblines of Old Hall Road

Old Hall Road, Whitefield – Both sides from the south-easterly kerblines of Ringley Rd for a distance of 15 m in a southerly direction


