Revisions to the original proposals include the reduction of bay length on the east of Walmersley Road and the changing of the bay from a shared use loading and limited waiting bay to be loading only. The reason for this is to remove a pinch point and to improve the alignment of the carriageway lanes at this location which will help improve free flowing traffic and reduce congestion.

The proposals also link in with Transport for Greater Manchester's aims of reducing congestion on strategic road corridors throughout Greater Manchester and help fulfil the Council's obligations of keeping the strategic road network free of congestion and obstructions as per the Traffic Management Act 2004.
