Background

Bury has been allocated £4.5M from the Greater Manchester City Region Sustainable Transport Settlements (CRSTS) for the period 2022/23 to 2026/27 for highway maintenance on the Key Route Network (KRN).

The KRN CRSTS funding was approved under Delegated powers 772 on 1 July 2022.

The implementation and access to use the Greater Manchester Highways Alliance Framework to procure Civil Engineering works was approved at cabinet (item 120) on 29 July 2020.

The Final evaluation and the selection of preferred bidders under the Greater Manchester Highways Alliance Framework was approved under Delegated powers 297 dated 15 October 2021.

The above arrangements have been made to ensure the council is able to maximise the opportunity for securing best value. The approach promotes the principles of strong financial governance and is fully supported.
