1. Background

- 1.1. The Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulations 2014 provide that whilst a meeting of a local authority is open to the public any person attending is to be permitted to report on the meeting. The regulations further provide that a person attending a local authority meeting for the purpose of reporting on the meeting must, so far as practicable, be afforded reasonable facilities for doing so.
- 1.2. In terms of reporting on the meeting, a person may use any communication method, including the internet, to publish, post or otherwise share the results of the person's reporting activities. Publication and dissemination may take place at the time of the meeting or take place after the meeting.

- 1.3. "Reporting" is defined in the regulations as:
 - (a) filming, photographing or making an audio recording of proceedings at a meeting;
 - (b) using any other means for enabling persons not present to see or hear proceedings at a meeting as it takes place or later; or
 - (c) reporting or providing commentary on proceedings at a meeting, orally or in writing, so that the report or commentary is available as the meeting takes place or later to persons not present
- 1.4. There is no requirement for a local authority to permit oral reporting or oral commentary on a meeting as it takes place if the person reporting or providing the commentary is present at the meeting.
- 1.5 The Regulations make clear that the carrying out of these activities must not disrupt the proceedings of the meeting. However, as previously indicated, there is a requirement to offer "reasonable facilities." In its Guidance Note on the Regulations, the Department for Communities and Local Government advises members of the public that if they wish to carry out the activities referred to in 1.3 above, it is advisable to notify local authority staff in advance so that the necessary arrangements can be made.

2. Summary

2.1. Members are asked to approve delegated authority to the Assistant Director – Legal and Democratic Services to make amendments to the Council Constitution and Council Procedure Rules to incorporate the provisions of the Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulations 2014.
