	Councillor L Smith	Transport for Greater Manchester (TfGM) works with Bee Network operators to track punctuality data. 'On time' performance for Bee Network Bus and Tram, for the six-month period from																									

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		January 2026 to June 2026, is as below. A bus is considered 'on time' if it sets off between 1 minute early or up to 5 minutes late. This performance measure therefore indicates the proportion of services which are cancelled or terminated early.
